The New Birth: Resting in the Holy Ghost

Acts 2:37-39

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

Luke 11:13

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: *how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?*

The new birth is simple.

Whenever we read of the Holy Spirit baptism in the book of Acts, it is simple. People believed God and God filled them with His Spirit. Yet every Christian has probably wrestled with questions about their relationship to God: am I saved? Have I been filled with the Holy Spirit, etc.

In this study, I want to emphasize that the new birth is a supernatural experience, which makes it impossible for us to define in its specifics. When we focus on a having a particular experience, receiving a certain revelation, or attaining a level of perfection in our Christian life, <u>we unintentionally start seeking</u> <u>something else than Christ.</u> Without realizing it, we may have begun to seek God by works instead of faith, and as soon as we do that, we lose our rest and peace (see quotes below: "the Christian faith is built solidly upon rest"). Our works always hinder the move of God in our lives.

God is sovereign and will meet each individual as He chooses. In the Church Age Book, Bro. Branham attempts to make himself very clear on what the Baptism of the Holy Ghost is and what it isn't. He points us back to the scriptures and focuses on the promise that after you believe, God will baptize us with His Spirit. We believe on Him, continue to believe on Him and at some point, He will fulfill His promise. And the duration of that experience, from beginning to baptism with the Spirit, is to God—who is outside of time!—all one experience. I believe that the devil wants to divorce us from our experience of God, and Satan does all he can to get us to see our experience with God as something in the past that is no longer part of the present. But God will never leave us or forsake us.

The Christian life is built entirely upon rest.

10-1 I was saying somewhere, maybe here a few nights ago, I wanted to preach so bad, I preached to my wife in bed till twelve o'clock, just telling her of how glorious Jesus was. A text come in my heart. It kept burning me so great till I just couldn't rest with it. And I just said, "Honey, I want to preach to you a little while." And she roused up; by grace she listened.

I said, "**The Christian faith is based solidly upon rest.** That's right. A Christian is not tossed about. A Christian doesn't run from place to place. A Christian doesn't fuss, and fume, and worry about things. A Christian rests. It's all over. It's all finished for the believer at Calvary. That's right. Oh, sickness may comes and disappointments; but the Christian's at rest knowing this, that God's able to keep that which He has performed, knowing that no matter what the thing is, or

how it looks, there's neither sickness, sorrow, death; there's neither starvation or anything that can separate us from the love of God that's in Jesus Christ. We're at rest. Just let the old ship toss any way she wants to; the anchor holds.

E-45 The other night the Lord give me a message on resting. **The whole Christian principle is based upon rest**. I woke up about ten o'clock in the night. I didn't have no audience to preach to, and so I just, well, I went over and woke up my wife and preached to her till one o'clock in the morning about resting: good audience. **But I was burning in my heart, resting. I said, "Why are we troubled? 'Let not your hearts be troubled,' He said. We're just resting. 'Come to Me and ye shall find rest.** Take My yoke upon you, learn of Me,' finding rest."

Then, while... I said when you once come to Christ, once believe Him, once accept Him, enter into the rest, all the things of the world seems to die away. You've got rest then, rest to your soul. And you enter into that state, and there you are. You're resting then with Christ.

Bro. Branham: the baptism of the Holy Ghost is part of being born again.

Now before we leave this subject I want to make myself very clear on what the Baptism with the Holy Ghost is according to the Word. It is not according to me, and it is not according to you. It has to be according to "Thus saith the Lord," or we are falsely led. Amen.

144-3 To begin with you will notice that in my meetings when I have finished preaching an evangelistic service, or some teaching message, I cast the net and invite a response from the people. I ask them to come forward and receive the Holy Spirit. My Pentecostal friends, upon hearing me say this believe that I am inviting people to come forward to be baptized with the Holy Ghost because they are already born again. So when I invite those who are Spirit-filled to come and deal with those who have answered the invitation to receive the Spirit, these dear ones surge forward and deal with the people in such manner as to encourage them to yield to God and believe to speak in tongues. This has caused a great deal of confusion and I want to tell you exactly what I mean. I mean for the sinner to come forward and be born again, which is to be baptized into the body of Christ by the Holy Ghost which is exactly what took place at Pentecost when the church was launched. In other words, to be born of the Spirit is to be truly baptized with the Holy Ghost. It is one and the same.

145-1 Now here is my point. Too many of our modernists and even our fundamentalists (so-called) believe unto salvation at a certain specific time which in many cases is called "making a decision," and that has been called receiving Christ or being born again. Now to receive Christ is to receive His Spirit. To receive His Spirit is to be born again. To receive His Spirit is to be baptized with the Holy Ghost. Amen. These folks believe. That is wonderful. But they stop there. You receive the Holy Ghost AFTER you believe. It has always been that way and always will be. The very first word of direction to the people was by Peter at Pentecost and he said,

"Repent and be baptized every one of you, in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost,

For the promise is unto you and to your children and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call." These directions came as a direct answer from Peter relative to what had actually happened at Pentecost. What came to pass was that God according to Joel was pouring out the promised Holy Spirit upon all flesh. He was not poured out before that time or given before that time. This was it. But THIS was to come from now on by repenting, being baptized in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and then God was duty bound to fill the ones who came. Peter, or any of the apostles never said, "Ye must be born again, and then filled with the Spirit."

To us who like to approach the promise with a checklist mentality (I've repented, I've been baptized, now I'm ready for the Spirit), God is sovereign and will fulfill His Word to fill the believer in His time.

167-111 Now, notice, the Holy Spirit come back there. The Pentecostal people waited, "And there--suddenly there came a sound from heaven like a rushing mighty wind, filled the house where they were sitting."

Not one time did they ever have to wait after that. While Peter spake these Words to the Gentiles, the Holy Ghost fell on them, even before they was baptized. Is that right? While... Acts 10:49:

(That's right; no waiting, no tarrying.)...

167-113 The apostolic way, God had no set rule: When the heart's hungry He'll give you what you're hungering for. If you want the Holy Ghost, It can fall on you right now.

Peter, when he went down to preach... Peter had the keys to the Kingdom. (I've got a question to get to that in a few minutes.) He had the keys to the Kingdom. He opened it up to this house of Cornelius. He opened it up down to the Samaritans; he opened it up over here. But remember that Philip had went down there, and preached to them, and had baptized them in the Name of Jesus Christ; and Peter came down and laid hands on them. And now, he done something for that sorcerer down there. They had Simon the sorcerer, said, "I'll give you some money to give me that gift, that whoever I lay my hands upon receives the Holy Ghost." Is that right? Something happened. (Not some of these archbishops with their collar turned around in the back, come around and lay hands on them, said, "I give you the apostolic blessing.") Something happened when Peter laid his hands on them, and when they do yet. I've seen them just fall like flies like that, as the Holy Spirit strikes them by laying on of hands. Yes, that is the--the apostolic doctrine of laying on hands. God bless you. If you're a little different from that, just write me a note tomorrow night. All right.

Matthew 5:6

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

- → You're blessed just because you're desiring the blessing! This testifies to the truth that you couldn't have a deep desire for something that didn't exist. The desire testifies that there is something to fulfill it!
- → When we seek God "in desperations", it doesn't mean we're in the depths of despair. Despair carries a negative meaning. Desperation doesn't mean despairing: it means we have an acute need and hunger to God and that we're looking to Him in faith!

Satan uses confusion about the new birth experience to rob us of the blessings of what God has *already done for us.*

John 3:8

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

The spiritual nature of the new birth makes particulars difficult to pin down. Leave it that way, and let God be God. WHO.IS.THIS_ CLARKSVILLE.IN SUNDAY_ 59-1004M

E-42 Now, that was His Message. That's what He said, that it must be done. That's what we've got to do, is to make a decision. What will we do with It? It's here. Who is It? What is It? It's a promise of God by His Word that He'd do it. God promised He would do it, and we see it being done.

Now, it's up to us to make a decision: Will we serve? Will we understand? You say, "How will I be able, brother, to understand things that I know nothing about?"

Jesus said to Nicodemus, "Except a man be borned again, he cannot see or understand the Kingdom of heaven." Said, "The wind blows where it list--listeth, and thou cannot tell from whence it come or whither it goes (which a way it come from or where it's going, or where it's been); so is everyone that's borned of the Spirit." Sometimes we get so focused on trying to figure out the particular of our own experience that we miss the forest for the trees. There is abundant proof that we ARE alive ... we're not concerned about the details. In fact, an obsession on proving to ourselves that we are actually born would actually hinder part of our life experience!

I don't mean to add to the Word, or take from It, because we're not to do that. Revelations 22 said, "Whoever will add a word, or take a Word out of It." But let me just make this, as not an additive, but just to--to bring out a point. "In My Father's House is many kinds of mansions." <u>I don't believe that when we get to Heaven that we will be, just</u> <u>everybody look just exactly alike.</u> I don't believe that--that all will be blondes, or brunettes, or--or little, or--or all big, or-or all giants.

<u>I believe that God is a God of variety. The world proves that.</u> He's got big mountains and little mountains. He's got plains. He's got deserts. He's got different things, because He made it the way He wanted it. And He made the seasons; summer, winter, spring, autumn. He made the seasons. It shows **He's a God of variety. He made you in a variety. Some men are real blusterous; and some are real dogmatic; and others are fine; others are kind. And you just find all different kinds of people, <u>and in His Kingdom.</u> See?**

46 <u>Look at Saint Peter, and judge him by Andrew. See? Andrew is that prayer warrior, just stayed on his knees all the time. And the apostle Peter was one of those firebrands that preached, and--and so forth. And Paul was more scholarly-like, more of the... like the prophet, or something, and set back.</u>

<u>47</u> And, see, Moses wrote the first four Books of the Old. Which, he wrote the Old Testament. The rest of it was the laws, and kings, and psalms, and so forth, and what someone wrote of the prophets. But Moses wrote the laws, the first four Books of the Bible: Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, and Deuteronomy.

<u>48</u> And then Paul wrote the New Testament. That's true. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John wrote the acts of what taken place, and so forth. But Paul separated law and grace, and put it into its place. See? He was the writer of the New Testament. He gave us the writings of the New Testament, setting the Word of God in order. Now notice, many, "many mansions," many kinds of mansions.

The important thing is that the Holy Spirit works in your life. Leave the *how* up to Him!

Now you can begin to see why tongues is not the evidence of being baptized with the Holy Ghost. It doesn't say in any age that "he that hath a tongue let him say what the Spirit is saying." That puts tongues, interpretation thereof, and prophecy, etc. aside as an evidence. The evidence is HEARING what the Spirit says. The Spirit is talking. Yes, the Spirit is teaching. That is exactly what Jesus said He would do when He came.

John 14:26

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Revelation 2:7

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches...

Matthew 13:16, contra. 13:36 (The disciples didn't understand everything, but they did see their was something to be seen.)

¹⁶But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear.

³⁶Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, <u>Declare</u> <u>unto us the parable of the tares of the field.</u>

Don't impersonate someone else's experience.

147-2 SMYRNAEAN.CHURCH.AGE - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK CPT.4

What is it that caused this misunderstanding? The answer is, "EXPERIENCE". We have gone by experience and not the Word. Away with experience as your measuring line. There is only one plumb line, only one rod, and that is the

WORD. Now watch carefully and get this. Peter said, "Repent and be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sin and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Paul said, "Have ye received the Holy Ghost SINCE ye believed?" This is the whole of our problem right here. People repent of their sins, they get baptized in water, BUT THEY DON'T GO ON AND RECEIVE THE HOLY GHOST. YOU BELIEVE UNTO RECEIVING THE SPIRIT.

Believing on Jesus is the step in the right direction which is toward the Holy Ghost. But the people stop there. They go as far as water and then stop. They believe, and then stop. The Bible does not say that you receive WHEN you believe. It is, "Have you received the Holy Ghost SINCE you believed?" The exact and literal translation is: "Did ye, having previously believed, receive the Holy Ghost?" The people believe and then stop. You don't receive the Holy Ghost when you believe UNTO Him, having repented. You go on and receive the Holy Ghost. Do you see it? That is what is wrong with our fundamentalists. They have no power for they stop short of Pentecost.

When we impersonate someone else's experience (or revelation) we are pushing ourselves into something that is a sovereign work of God. Our well-intended efforts can thus work to frustrate the work of God!

Galatians 2:20-21

<u>I am crucified with Christ</u>: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but <u>Christ liveth in me</u>: and <u>the life which I now live in the flesh I</u> <u>live by the faith of the Son of God</u>, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Now you just believe with all your heart. Don't doubt. Don't doubt. Just have faith in God. Let's start looking on this side over here somewhere. Somebody just look. See? <u>Just relax yourself,</u> <u>and say, "Well, sure, that's the Word. I believe It.</u> That little, old fellow up there doesn't know me. But I know Jesus. He's told the Truth about the Word, and I believe it." Just do it like that, say, "I'm sick and needy, and I have need." I can't heal you, and this don't heal, but it only identifies.

Now then, here we are coming to a conclusion. As the eternal Logos (God) was manifest in the Son, and in Jesus dwelt all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and that Eternal One was the Father manifest in flesh, and thereby gained the title of Son, even so we, eternal in His thoughts in our turn became the many membered Spoken Word Seed, manifest in flesh, and those eternal thoughts now manifest in flesh are the sons of God, even as we are so called. **WE DID NOT BECOME SEED BY THE REBIRTH, WE WERE SEED AND THEREFORE WERE REBORN FOR ONLY THE ELECT CAN BE REBORN.** Because we WERE SEED is the reason we could be quickened. In NON-SEED there is nothing to quicken.
